Community Volunteer Income Tax Program at the St. Albert Food Bank and Community Village *Please note, we are not providing in person tax appointments. We ask that you drop off your slips to us beginning February 24th.

Volunteers, trained by the Canada Revenue Agency, can help you complete your income tax and benefit return:

<u>Eligibility Requirements</u>:

Family Size Maximum Income

1 person \$35,000

2 persons (couple) \$45,000

For each dependent, add \$2,500 to the above income level

The Community Volunteer Income Tax Program does not prepare taxes for:

- Farming and fishing income
- Self-employed income
- Deceased persons
- Interest exceeding \$1,000.
- Rental/business income
- Bankruptcies
- Capital gains or losses
- Foreign income

What you need to bring: (mandatory) All relevant information slips such as:

- T4, T4A (old age security)
- T5007 slips (social assistance)
- Tuition, education slips
- Notice(s) of Assessment
- Public Transit receipts
- Photo I.D.

- T2201 slip (disability)
- Medical receipts (obtain printed copy of receipts from pharmacy).
- Child Care receipts, name/address of licensed daycare
